

When 17-year-old Christy is kicked out of his foster home, he is released into the care of his half-brother Shane and back into the community of his childhood. Having tragically lost his mother when he was very young, he has little connection to the community and struggles to settle in. Slowly the locals start to connect with Christy, offering him hope.


